DO YOU HAVE A CHILD SUPPORT ORDER AND COURT-ORDERED PARENTING TIME WITH YOUR CHILD?

If so, there is a new law that may affect you. Starting August 1, 2018 the new child support calculation better accounts for the time and money both parents spend with their children during their parenting time.

CHILD SUPPORT ORDERS WILL NOT CHANGE AUTOMATICALLY.

First, you need a court order for parenting time that includes how much time each parent spends with their children. Next, you must file a motion asking the court to change your child support.

3 WAYS TO FIND OUT IF THIS NEW LAW APPLIES TO YOU:

If you have a Ramsey County Child Support case:
