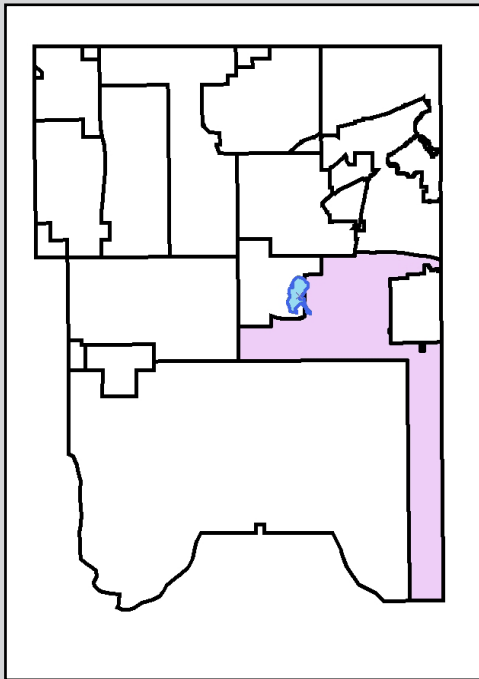
Project Goal:

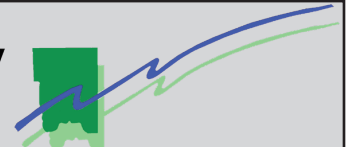
Project Funding:
