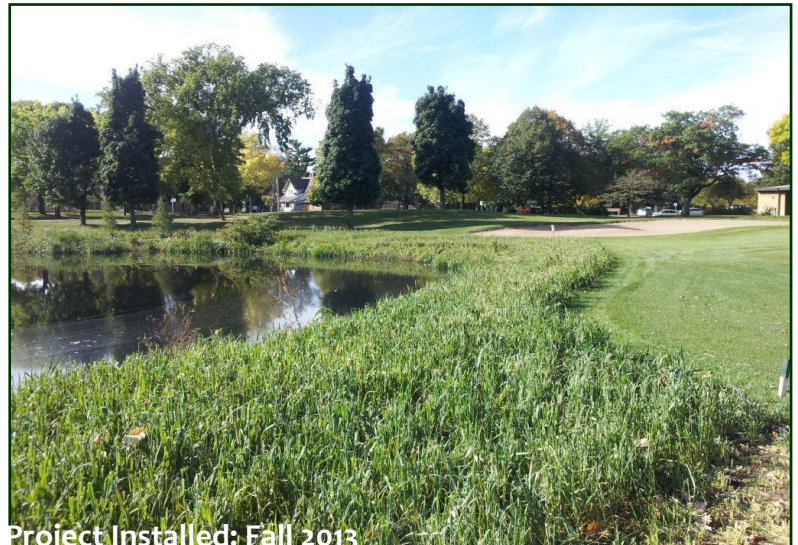
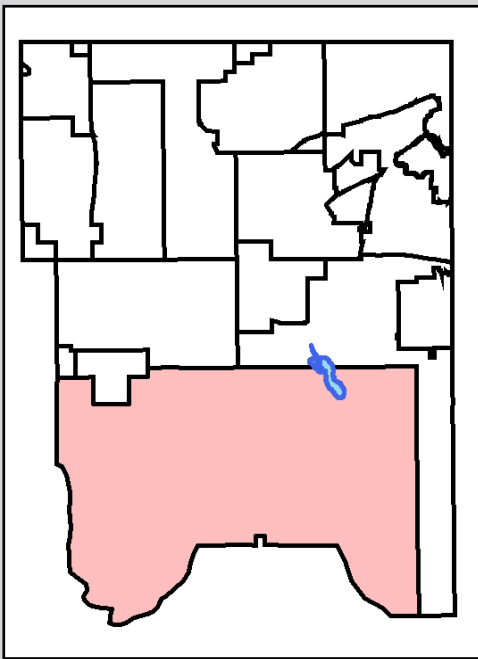
LAKE PHALEN AREA, ST. PAUL, MN
