C. Reimbursement for FY13 Cost Share Project: **Resolution 15-09-03**. Supervisor Behrens moved and Supervisor Willems seconded. Resolved the Board approved the following:

The MN BWSR has provided \$150,000.00 in both FY2013 and FY2014 for Clean Water Funds through the Community Partners Conservation Program Grant to the RCD for water quality projects installed on Faith Organization, School, and Business properties;

Whereas, the BWSR cost-share shall not exceed 75% of the total construction cost; and Whereas, the RCD Board of Supervisors designates, Joe Lochner, District Staff as the technical representative for this project. Former RCD staff Ryan Johnson was the original technical representative for the project but due to staff turnover, Joe Lochner is now the technical representative.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, the RCD Board agrees to approve reimbursement payment in the following amounts:

Twin Cities German Immersion School – St. Paul: Spokesperson Ann Jurewicz at 1031 Como Ave (formerly 1030 Van Slyke Ave), St. Paul, MN 55103, bio-retention basins.

Contract #CP FY13-01, Conservation Practice 570; Total Project Cost: \$90,212.91; BWSR Cost Share for eligible components: 24%/\$21,500.00 (FY13 \$20,603.24, FY14 \$896.75). Local Watershed Cost Share for eligible components: CRWD-29%/ 26,450.00, Landowner Contribution: 47%/\$42,262.91. Technical and Administrative amount to be consistent with percentages outlined in grant work plan.

D. Encumbrance for FY14 and FY15 Cost Share Project: **Resolution 15-09-04**. Supervisor Behrens moved and Supervisor Wasley seconded. Resolved the Board approved the following: Whereas, The MN BWSR has provided \$150,000 in FY2014 and 2015 Clean Water Funds through the Community Partners Conservation Program Grant to the RCD for water quality projects installed on Faith Organizations, Schools, and Business properties; and Whereas, the 2015 Community Partners Grant also included Home Owner Associations; and Whereas, the BWSR cost-share shall not exceed 75% of the total construction cost; and Whereas, the RCD Board of Supervisors designates, Joe Lochner, Ramsey Conservation District Staff as the technical representative for these projects.

Now therefore Be It Resolved, the RCD Board agrees to enter into BWSR cost-share agreements with the following:

Wendy's Four Crown, Inc.: Spokesperson Greg Heck: 256 Holdings, LLC & Double Dragon Bldg, Inc. c/o Harrington Langer & Associates at 612 University Ave West, St. Paul, MN 55103 for infiltration basins, perimeter fence, and educational signage.

Contract #CP 14-02, Conservation Practice 570; Total Project Cost: \$69,517.20; BWSR Cost Share for eligible components: 35%/\$24,517.41. Local Watershed (Capitol Region Watershed District) Cost Share for eligible components: 41%/\$28,484.10. Landowner Contribution: 24%/\$16,515.69. Technical and Administrative amount to be consistent with percentages outlined in grant work plan. The project must be started by December 1, 2015 and completed by December 1, 2016, unless otherwise amended by mutual consent and agreement by both parties.

Victoria Village Atrium Condominiums.: Spokesperson Robert Hoffman: President, of Victoria Village Atrium Condominiums at 4035 Victoria Street N, Unit #119, Shoreview, MN 55126 for the infiltration basin.

Contract #CP 15-01, Conservation Practice 570; Total Project Cost: \$15,899.68; BWSR Cost Share for eligible components: 42%/\$6,677.86. Local Watershed (Rice Creek Watershed District) Cost Share for eligible components: 31%/\$5,000. Landowner Contribution: 27%/\$4,221.82. Technical and Administrative amount to be consistent with percentages outlined in grant work plan. The project must be started by October 14, 2015 and completed by October 14, 2016, unless otherwise amended by mutual consent and agreement by both parties.

E. Approval of BWSR Grant Agreement for Buffer Law and MDA's Agricultural Water Quality Certification Program. Ann explained that the BWSR Board approved grant allocations to SWCDs for the implementation of the new buffer law and for MDA's Agricultural Water Quality Certification Program (MAWQCP). The buffer funding would require the RCD to host meetings with shoreland and drainage authorities (Watershed Districts) to discuss implementation roles and responsibilities. The RCD would be required to promote education and outreach efforts for the MAWQCP funding. **Resolution 15-09-05.** Supervisor Wasley moved and Supervisor Willems seconded. Resolved the Board approved the acceptance of \$3,000 for Buffer Implementation and \$2,000 for MAWQCP and authorized staff to submit the request to BWSR by the October 14, 2015 deadline.

F. State of the Waters Update: Ann provided details on the State of the Waters. Speakers include Jim Bode of St. Paul Regional Water, Mark Burch with the City of White Bear Lake, Tim LaPara from the University of Minnesota, and Karla Peterson at the Minnesota Department of Public Health. Resolution **15-09-06** Supervisor Behrens moved and Supervisor Willems seconded. Resolved the Board approved up to \$300 to be spent on consumables for the event.

G. Training Authorization: RCD allows permanent employees a \$500 allowance per year for professional development/conference attendance. Temporary employees do not have an allowance for professional development. Ann requested an exception to allow for any interested staff to attend the BWSR Academy in 2015. **Resolution 15-09-07.** Supervisor Behrens moved and Supervisor Willems seconded. Resolved the Board approved expenses for any and all RCD staff to attend two days at the BWSR academy training, including one night of lodging.

H. Strategic Planning: RCD has been allotted a total of \$200,000 for 2016 and 2017. Ann suggested replacing the November 9, 2015 board meeting for a strategic planning workshop to develop a plan of how to use the new funds. The RCD Board and staff, as well as Ramsey County Commissioners, will be invited to the workshop on November 9, 2015. **Resolution 15-09-08.** Supervisor Wasley moved and Supervisor Behrens second. Resolved the Board approved changing the November 9, 2015 board meeting to include a workshop on the 2016-17 budget.
