GENERAL PROVISIONS:

The applicant must notify and obtain a permit from any township or city through which it passes if said township or city so requires. Obtaining a right of way permit does not relieve permittee of its duty to obtain all other necessary permits, licenses, and authority and to pay all fees required by the County or other applicable rule, law or regulation. Permittee shall comply with other local codes and with road load restrictions. A permittee shall comply with all requirements of local, state and federal laws, including Minnesota Statutes Ch. 216D (“One Call Excavation Notice System). A permittee shall perform all work in conformance with all applicable codes and established rules and regulations, and is responsible for all work done in the right of way pursuant to this Permit, General and Special Provisions, regardless of who does the work.

The Contractor shall provide a 48-hour notice of intent to begin construction to the Ramsey County Permit Office (651) 266-7186.

All contractors, sub-contractors and sub-sub-contractors must be named on the Permit as “Joint Applicants” or additional permits are required.

All lane closures shall be in accordance with the appropriate layout in the “Minnesota Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices”.

All “Detours” must be approved by the County Traffic Engineer a minimum of 72 hours in advance of scheduled closures.

Permittee is responsible for contacting Ramsey County Land Survey for locating any Survey Monuments within the construction area; any damage to survey monuments shall be borne by the Permittee. (651) 266-7173

If the project cannot be finished in the time allotted, an additional permit will be required or a delay penalty shall be imposed. The date of the release of the “Construction Performance Bond” is determined by the date that Ramsey County receives the Completion Certificate. (See permit timetable in the “Fee Schedule” for timing requirements).
