WHAT TO DO

STEP 1: Put empty syringes (needle side down) into a hard container such as a laundry detergent jug.

STEP 2: Seal container and label it "SHARPS."

STEP 3: Tell staff at collection site you have sharps.

Bring full syringes to a medicine collection drop box. Loose sharps are not accepted. No business waste.

Check the label. If it says **CAUTION, WARNING, DANGER** or **POISON**, it doesn't belong in the trash unless the container is empty.
